Dear Parents,

I am delighted to let you know that we are planning an educational visit on **Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> June** to Carr Mill Dam, Merseyside for our Year 3 and 4 pupils accompanied by myself, Miss Evans, Mrs McColl, Mr Garrett, Mrs Carswell and another to be confirmed closer to the date. Carr Mill Dam is home to the Mountain Monkeys activity centre. Here the children will be developing team work skills, resilience, confidence and independence. The activities that we will be participating in as small instructor-led groups will be kayaking, rock climbing, air-rifle shooting and orienteering.

Our visit will be a full day and we are currently aiming to leave school at around 8.30am in order to arrive at the centre for around 9.30am and we plan to leave the centre at 3.30pm, arriving back at school at around 4.15pm (further details will be sent in due course). We will be having a packed lunch which can be ordered from school if required. Closer to the day, you will be sent a medical and emergency contact form, a lunch ordering form and a list of what your child will need to bring with them

The price for the day visit is £29 which includes the coach, 2 morning activities and 2 afternoon sessions and we are requesting a deposit of £15.00 to secure our booking by  $21^{st}$  May 2021. The remaining £14.00 should be paid by  $18^{th}$  June 2021. Please pay via Parentpay, if you have any issues accessing Parentpay, please contact the school office.
