What? (Key knowledge)			
Significant historical people:			
Guy Fawkes	Born in York in 1570. He was a catholic. He became involved in a plot to kill King James I.		
Robert Catesby	Gunpowder plot leader.		
Thomas Percy	A royal bodyguard. He rented a space in a cellar directly underneath the Houses of Parliament.		
King James I	In 1605 he was the King of England. Some people did not like him as, under his rule, England was a Protestant country and some people were Catholic.		
Gunpowder plot events			
Meeting up	In 1605, a group of young Catholic men met to talk about how angry they were with King James I.		
Making a plan	They decided to blow up the Houses of Parliament with the King inside!		
Gunpowder	They decided to use gunpowder but didn't know how to get it into Parliament.		
Moving the gunpowder	Thomas Percy rented a space in a cellar directly underneath the Houses of Parliament. They moved 36 barrels of gunpowder into the cellar.		
Plotters plan ruined!	On 26 th October 1605, Lord Monteagle received a letter from a mysterious stranger! It warned him not to open Parliament on 5 th November!		
Caught in the act!	Lord Monteagle showed his letter to the King. On the morning of 5 th November, the King's guards searched the cellar and found Guy Fawkes hiding with the barrels of gunpowder!		
Plan ruined!	Guy Fawkes confessed and was executed.
