### **EYFS Car Park Improvements**

Over the summer, some important improvements were made to the EYFS car park, including new railings and safety bollards. These changes have been put in place to help keep our children safe. Please take care when manoeuvring your car in and out of the car park as it is a relatively tight space. We kindly ask that pedestrians do not use the vehicle entrance and always stick to the designated walkways. Only Nursery and Reception families are permitted to use the EYFS car park; all other classes should use the Middle Lane entrance (main entrance) when arriving and leaving school. Thank you for your cooperation in helping us keep the area safe for everyone.

### Uniform and Water Bottles

The children look very smart in their uniforms today — thank you for your support with this. Please ensure:

- Uniform is clearly labelled with your child's name
- Children bring a **labelled water bottle** each day to stay hydrated
