What? (Key knowledge)

Columbus	
the Santa Maria	The flagship ship of Christopher Columbus. Sailed by 53 men.
Christopher Columbus	An explorer and navigator from Genoa who completed four voyages across the Atlantic Ocean
The Americas	The land Columbus accidentally found on his way to Asia

MacArthur

Ellen MacArthur	MacArthur is a successful solo long-distance yachtswoman. On 7 February 2005 she broke the world record for the fastest solo circumnavigation of the globe
Atlantic	The Atlantic Ocean is the second-largest of the world's oceans. This was crossed on Ellen's solo voyage
Solo Voyage	A journey across the sea that is completed on your own with now crew—this is what Ellen did!!!
Trimaran	The type of boat used by Ellen on her Voyage
