Tent	8 soldiers were put together into a group called a 'Tent'	
Century	10 'tents' were put together to form a century of 80 men. A Centurion was in charge of the Century	
Cohort	Six Centuries were put together to create a Cohort of 480 men.	
Legion	10 Cohorts were joined together to form a Legion.	
Roman inventions		
Concrete	to help make their buildings strong- er and easier to build.	
Newspapers.	First invented in the year 131 BC. They were called 'Acta Diurna' which means 'Daily acts',	
Books	The Romans were the first civilisation to bind pages together.	
Calendar	The calendar used today is based mostly upon the Julian calendar (named after Julius Caesar) which split the year up into 12 months.	
Central heat- ing	The Romans called it 'hypocaustum'. It involved moving hot air through hollow walls and
