Apollo 11	Apollo 11 was the spaceflight that first landed humans on the Moon.

Pilot	Neil got his first pilot's license at just 16 years old.

American	Neil was born in Ohio, America in 1930.
Teacher	Neil became a university teacher in 1971 because he struggled with the limelight.

Possible Experiences

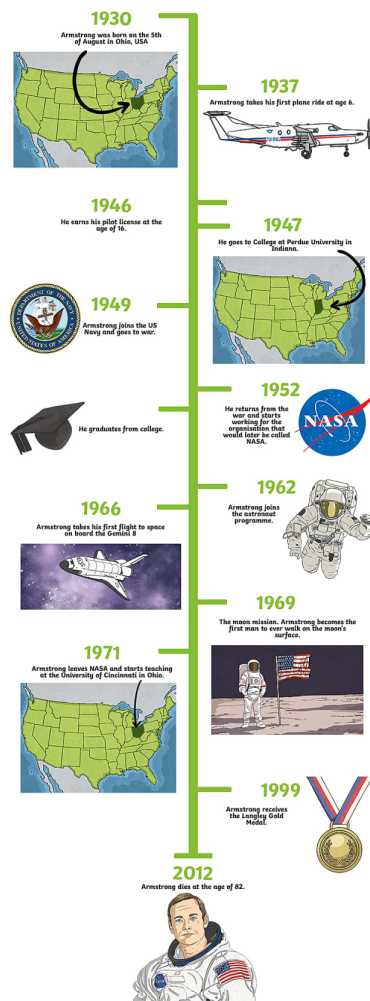
- Trip to Jodrell Bank Discovery Centre which has a giant Lovell telescope.
